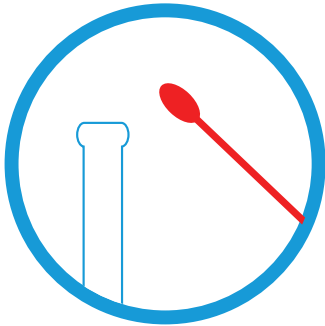
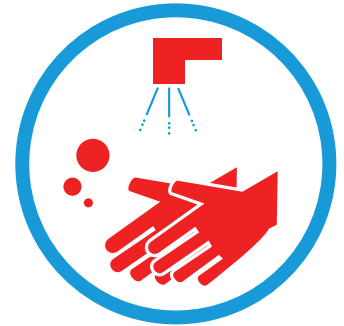


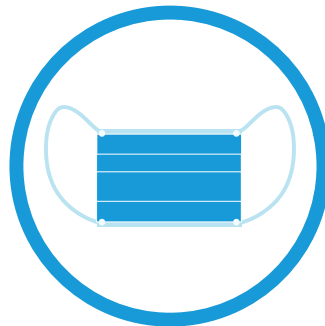
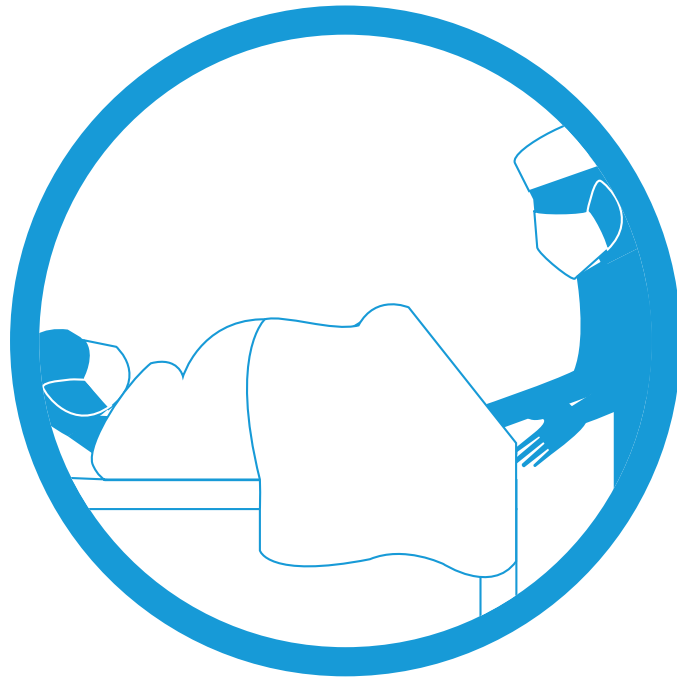
I'm pregnant. What can I expect when having a baby during the COVID-19 pandemic?
